QRW and The Maurice Wilkins Centre are pleased to offer three scholarships for high-school biology teachers to attend the Queenstown Molecular Biology science conference to be held from the 28th – 30th August 2023 at the Rydges Hotel, Queenstown, New Zealand.

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide New Zealand’s Science teachers with:

- 1) exposure to cutting edge research from National and International Scientists.
- 2) links with some of New Zealand’s leading researchers.
- 3) links with providers of scientific equipment and supplies.
- 4) links with top science teachers from around New Zealand.

The scholarships will cover conference registration, accommodation, and travel to and from Queenstown.

This year the Queenstown lecture will be given by Professor David Julius – winner of the 2021 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine.
